Sentence Exercise for (al)

1. Will you pass me the salt?
2. Bud likes to write with white chalk.
3. Ann drank a malted milk with her lunch.
4. Did you go to Wal-Mart with your sister?
5. We like to talk while we are going for a walk.
6. Mr. Smith is a bald man.
7. We saw the mule balk and the farmer got mad.
8. Mrs. Walter will scald the milk.
9. See the black cat stalk that bird.

Exceptions: balm, calm, palm, qualm. (the "l" is silent and the "a" pronounced like in "father".)

Exceptions: half, calf. (the "l" is silent and the "a" is short as in apple.)
